As many will be aware, the Church of England has been exploring questions of identity, sexuality, relationships and marriage through the Living in Love and Faith process. I am conscious that current deliberations in the Church of England on LLF are a source of deep anxiety and pain for many, for a variety of different reasons, and that there will be different feelings, questions and views within our church family.

I would like to offer two small group sessions for those who would like the opportunity to share their hopes, fears and questions in a safe space and to look at the Bible together. These will take place at church on 21st and 28th June, from 7.30-9pm. In the first session, we will look at the 'Pastoral Principles' and in the second we will look at some Bible passages together. You're invited to attend both sessions and the focus of both sessions will be on listening to one another.
